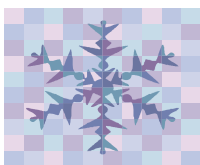


YELLOW ROOM NEWS

STAFF CHANGES

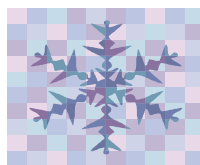
The yellow room has been experiencing some staff changes over the past couple of months.

Meg- Full-time

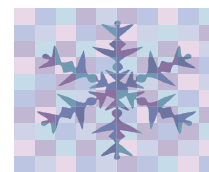
Maria- Full-time
